


Online Guidelines

- To enter a session you need to follow its link under the "Scientific Program" tab of www.ct-meeting.org.
- Each session is its own zoom meeting:
 - A waiting room is enabled.
 - Chairs and authors are supposed to enter their session 15 minutes in advance and to raise their hand. They will then be let into the meeting.
 - The audience will be let in from the waiting room into the meeting one minute before the session starts. In case of delays: please wait until you will be let in.
 - The session will be recorded. Recordings will be available about one day later for about six weeks.
 - When the session ends the zoom meeting will end as well, i.e. all participants will be removed from the zoom meeting.
 - To enter the next session you need to follow its link under the "Scientific Program" tab of www.ct-meeting.org
- Mute your microphone if it is not your turn to speak.
- Raise your hand if you have a question.

Poster Sessions
